Course Description:

The general idea of the internship is to encourage students to apply the concepts learned throughout their study program and be able to gain practical knowhow, based on real case scenarios.

Course Goals:

1. Understand the workplace dynamics, professional expectations, and the influence they have on job performance
2. Clarify professional and career goals through critical analysis of the internship, collaborating with other colleagues and understand job responsibilities
3. Gain field experience in tourism industry through real case scenarios
4. Be able to apply concepts learned thought the study program

Course Requirements: An important goal of teaching is to develop the capacity for independent, analytical thinking and being able to report such thoughts, to develop practical managerial ability. Students should participate in various class discussions, group projects, oral presentation regarding their practical experience. For the student is mandatory to attend 75 % of the hours assigned to the business or organization for the internship.

Grading: The final grade is composed by:

- Final Presentation: 60 points
- Participation and reference: 40 points

The final grade is composed by: 60% of the practice assessment through the task of the individual course specified in the program of internship and 40% of the performance of the supervisor performance by the subject of the student practice.

Course Schedule: The professional internship lasts 14 weeks where for each week the student works 5 days with 5 hours a day. Also, three days is spent on an research tour in a tourist destinations in Albania.
