## **Course Description**

**Course Title:** Social Psychology

**Course Credits:** 8 ECTS

Language of Instruction: Albanian

**Course Description**: Scientific study of the way people think, feel and behave in social situations.

This course offers a rich theoretical framework from the sources of psychological literature of recent years, as well as illustrating and concretizing the knowledge with examples chosen from everyday's social life.

Topics include social identity, social cognition, attribution, attitudes, persuasion, interpersonal relationship, prosocial behaviour, aggression, conformity and other psychological aspects of the social groups.

**Course Goals**: A primary goal is to introduce the students to the perspectives, research methods, and empirical findings of social psychology. Equally important is the goal to cultivate student skills of analyzing the social situations and events that they encounter in their everyday lives.

## **Course Requirements:**

- Active participation including class discussions, practical cases, review articles, interactive exercises, role play, quizzes and home assignments from course material.
- Semestral tests with multiple choice and open questions (short answer), true/false, matching etc.
- *Course assignment* designed to give the students chance to relate course material to the social world in which they live.
- Final exam with multiple choice questions, open questions, case studies etc.

**Grading**: Credits are equivalent to grades 5 - 10. No Credit is equivalent to grade 4. Grades will be earned according to the following points: 10 = 95-100, 9 = 85-94, 8 = 75-84, 7 = 65-74, 6 = 55-64, 5 = 45-54 and 4 = 44 or lower.

**Course Schedule**: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester. Hours in auditorium 90 (lectures 60 and seminars 30).
