Course Title: Psychology of children with special needs

Course Credits: 6

Language of Instruction: Albanian.

Course Description: "Psychology of children with special needs" subject takes place in the study program " Professional master in "Social services", Course I.

Course Goals: Through this course, students of this study program receive get in-depth knowledge about the special needs of the child. Students gain knowledge about the main types of special needs and their impact on the education process and about the role of the family in the education of their child with special needs.

Course Requirements: The final assessment will be reflected in the amount of points that students have accumulated based on the following:

- Active participation in the seminars hours - 10 points (maximum).
- Intermediate exam -10 points (maximum).
- Course assignment - 20 points (maximum).
- Final written exam - 60 points (maximum).

Grading: Grade 10 (96-100 points); Grade 9 (86-95 points); Grade 8 (76-85 points); Grade 7 (66-75 points); Grade 6 (56-65 points); Grade 5 (45-55 points); Grade 4 (less than 45 points).

Course Schedule: This course takes place in the second semester, with weekly academic workload 2/1 (two hours lectures, one hour seminar). Lecture attendance is not mandatory. Seminar attendance is mandatory in 75% of hours.
